BIBLE QUIZ: Psalm 119:17-32 & Luke 5:1-11

Memory Theme - "Taking Heed Thereto According To Thy Word"

- 1. Genesis 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I *am* thy shield, *and* thy exceeding great reward.
- 2. Exodus 9:20 He that feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh made his servants and his cattle flee into the houses:
- 3. Exodus 9:21 And he that regarded not the word of the LORD left his servants and his cattle in the field.
- 4. 1 Kings 12:6 And king Rehoboam consulted with the old men, that stood before Solomon his father while he yet lived, and said, How do ye advise that I may answer this people?
- 5. 1 Kings 12:7 And they spake unto him, saying, If thou wilt be a servant unto this people this day, and wilt serve them, and answer them, and speak good words to them, then they will be thy servants for ever.
- 6. 1 Kings 12:8 But he forsook the counsel of the old men, which they had given him, and consulted with the young men that were grown up with him, *and* which stood before him:
- 7. 1 Kings 12:9 And he said unto them, What counsel give ye that we may answer this people, who have spoken to me, saying, Make the yoke which thy father did put upon us lighter?
- 8. 1 Kings 12:10 And the young men that were grown up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou speak unto this people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou *it* lighter unto us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little *finger* shall be thicker than my father's loins.
- 9. 1 Kings 16:34 In his days did Hiel the Bethelite build Jericho: he laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn, and set up the gates thereof in his youngest *son* Segub, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Joshua the son of Nun.
- 10. Psalm 51:2 Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.
- 11. Psalm 51:3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.
- 12. Psalm 119:25 My soul cleaveth unto the dust: quicken thou me according to thy word.
- 13. Psalm 119:28 My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word.
- 14. Psalm 119:160 Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth for ever.
- 15. Psalm 119:162 I rejoice at thy word, as one that findeth great spoil.
- 16. Psalm 138:2 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.
- 17. Ecclesiastes 4:8 There is one *alone*, and *there is* not a second; yea, he hath neither child nor brother: yet *is there* no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither *saith he*, For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good? This *is* also vanity, yea, it *is* a sore travail.
- 18. Ecc 4:9 Two *are* better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour.
- 19. Ecc 4:10 For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him *that is* alone when he falleth; for *he hath* not another to help him up.
- 20. Ecc 5:1 Keep thy foot when thou goest to the house of God, and be more ready to hear, than to give the sacrifice of fools: for they consider not that they do evil.
- 21. Ecc 5:2 Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter *any* thing before God: for God *is* in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.
- 22. Ecc 5:3 For a dream cometh through the multitude of business; and a fool's voice is known by multitude of words.
- 23. Ecc 5:4 When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for *he hath* no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed.
- 24. Ecc 5:5 Better is it that thou shouldest not vow, than that thou shouldest vow and not pay.
- 25. Ecc. 5:6 Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin; neither say thou before the angel, that it *was* an error: wherefore should God be angry at thy voice, and destroy the work of thine hands?
