Memory Theme – “Taking Heed Thereto According To Thy Word”

1. Judges 2:7 And the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD, that he did for Israel.
2. Judges 2:8 And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died, being an hundred and ten years old.
3. Judges 2:9 And they buried him in the border of his inheritance in Timnathheres, in the mount of Ephraim, on the north side of the hill Gaash.
4. Judges 2:10 And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.
5. Judges 2:11 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim:
6. Judges 2:12 And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger.
7. Judges 2:13 And they forsook the LORD, and served Baal and Ashtaroth.
8. Psalms 51:7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
9. Psalms 119:41 Let thy mercies come also unto me, O LORD, even thy salvation, according to thy word.
10. Psalms 119:42 So shall I have wherewith to answer him that reproacheth me: for I trust in thy word.
11. Psalms 119:58 I intreated thy favour with my whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word.
12. Psalms 119:65 Thou hast dealt well with thy servant, O LORD, according unto thy word.
13. Psalms 119:82 Mine eyes fail for thy word, saying, When wilt thou comfort me?
14. Psalms 119:89 For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.
15. 2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,
16. 2 Peter 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:
17. 2 Peter 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.
18. 2 Peter 1:5-7 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
19. 2 Peter 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
20. 2 Peter 1:9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.
21. Revelation 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.
22. Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
23. Revelation 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.
24. Revelation 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
25. Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
