BIBLE QUIZ: Psalm 119:169-176 & Luke 1:26-38

Memory Theme - "Taking Heed Thereto According To Thy Word"

- 1. Nehemiah 9:28 But after they had rest, they did evil again before thee: therefore leftest thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto thee, thou heardest them from heaven; and many times didst thou deliver them according to thy mercies;
- 2. Nehemiah 9:29 And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.
- 3. Nehemiah 9:30 Yet many years didst thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the people of the lands.
- 4. Nehemiah 9:31 Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou art a gracious and merciful God.
- 5. Nehemiah 9:32 Now therefore, our God, the great, the mighty, and the terrible God, who keepest covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before thee, that hath come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all thy people, since the time of the kings of Assyria unto this day.
- 6. Nehemiah 9:33 Howbeit thou art just in all that is brought upon us; for thou hast done right, but we have done wickedly:
- 7. Psalms 119:147 I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I hoped in thy word.
- 8. Psalms 119:169 Let my cry come near before thee, O LORD: give me understanding according to thy word.
- 9. Proverbs 8:10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.
- 10. Proverbs 8:11 For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.
- 11. Proverbs 8:15 By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.
- 12. Proverbs 8:16 By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth.
- 13. Proverbs 8:32 Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed are they that keep my ways.
- 14. Proverbs 8:33 Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.
- 15. Proverbs 8:34 Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.
- 16. Romans 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.
- 17. Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- 18. Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?
- 19. Galatians 4:16 Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?
- 20. Galatians 5:7 Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?
- 21. Revelation 22:1 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.
- 22. Revelation 22:2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, [was there] the tree of life, which bare twelve [manner of] fruits, [and] yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree [were] for the healing of the nations.
- 23. Revelation 22:3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:
- 24. Revelation 22:4 And they shall see his face; and his name [shall be] in their foreheads.
- 25. Revelation 22:5 And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.
