Memory Theme – "Taking Heed Thereto According To Thy Word"

- 1. Ezra 3:8 Now in the second year of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the remnant of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the Levites, from twenty years old and upward, to set forward the work of the house of the LORD.
- 2. Ezra 3:9 Then stood Jeshua with his sons and his brethren, Kadmiel and his sons, the sons of Judah, together, to set forward the workmen in the house of God: the sons of Henadad, with their sons and their brethren the Levites.
- 3. Ezra 3:10 And when the builders laid the foundation of the temple of the LORD, they set the priests in their apparel with trumpets, and the Levites the sons of Asaph with cymbals, to praise the LORD, after the ordinance of David king of Israel.
- 4. Ezra 3:11 And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.
- 5. Ezra 3:12 But many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, who were ancient men, that had seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, wept with a loud voice; and many shouted aloud for joy:
- 6. Ezra 3:13 So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of joy from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.
- 7. Psalm 50:14 Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High:
- 8. Psalm 69:30 I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving.
- 9. Psalm 95:2 Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.
- 10. Psalm 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.
- 11. Psalm 116:17 I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.
- 12. Psalms 119:17 Deal bountifully with thy servant, that I may live, and keep thy word.
- 13. Psalms 119:57 Thou art my portion, O LORD: I have said that I would keep thy words.
- 14. Psalms 119:154 Plead my cause, and deliver me: quicken me according to thy word.
- 15. Psalm 147:7 Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:
- 16. Matthew 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.
- 17. Matthew 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.
- 18. Matthew 12:35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.
- 19. Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.
- 20. Matthew 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
- 21. Colossians 4:1 Masters, give unto your servants that which is just and equal; knowing that ye also have a Master in heaven.
- 22. Colossians 4:2 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;
- 23. Colossians 4:3-4 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds: That I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.
- 24. Colossians 4:5 Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.
- 25. Colossians 4:6 Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.
